Undergraduate (Bachelors, BA, BSc)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• SSCE / WASSCE plus successful completion of a recognised foundation programme.</li><li>• SSCE / WASSCE plus first year of a recognised university degree.</li><li>• Normally holders of West Africa Higher School Certificate.</li><li>• Normally holders of a OND or HND from a recognised Ghanaian institution.</li><li>• 240 - 280 UCAS points at A level (eg grades BCC - BBC).</li><li>• IB Diploma at 25 points.</li></ul>
Postgraduate Taught (Masters, MA, MSc, MBA)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Normally a first or second class Bachelors degree from a recognised Ghanaian University.</li></ul>
English Language Requirement	Undergraduate: IELTS 6.0, TOEFL paper based 550, TOEFL ibt 79, UK O level/GCSE grade C, or other equivalent recognised English qualification. Postgraduate: IELTS 6.5, TOEFL paper based 560, TOEFL ibt 83, UK O level/GCSE grade C, or other equivalent recognised English qualification.

## Tuition Fees

Undergraduate tuition fees for 2009 = £6,800 per year  
Postgraduate Taught tuition fees for 2009 = £6,800 to £9,720 per year

Early payments discounts of between 5% - 10% are available.

Overseas Scholarship	Overseas Scholarships are available to both undergraduate and postgraduate applicants and are worth £1,000. Applications are welcome from students with first class academic marks.
International Postgraduate Scholarship	International Postgraduate Scholarships are available to postgraduate degree applicants and are worth half the tuition fees (e.g. 50% discount on fees). Applications are welcome from students who have achieved first class results in their final degree classification and can demonstrate high academic achievement and social and community involvement.
