Undergraduate (Bachelors, BA, BSc)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• 240 – 280 points at UK A level (eg grades CCC to BBC).</li><li>• SSCE / WAEC plus successful completion of a recognised foundation programme.</li><li>• SSCE / WAEC plus first year of a recognised university degree.</li><li>• Normally holders of OND or HND from a recognised Nigerian institution.</li><li>• IB Diploma at 25 points.</li><li>• Other entry qualifications may be accepted.</li></ul>
Postgraduate Taught (Masters, MA, MSc, MBA)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Normally a first or second class Bachelors degree from a recognised Nigerian University.</li></ul>
English Language Requirement	Undergraduate: IELTS 6.0, TOEFL paper based 550, TOEFL ibt 79, UK O level/GCSE grade C, WAEC C4 English or other equivalent recognised English qualification. Postgraduate: IELTS 6.5, TOEFL paper based 560, TOEFL ibt 83, UK O level/GCSE grade C, WAEC C4 English or other equivalent recognised English qualification.

Undergraduate tuition fees for 2009 = £6,800 per year  
Postgraduate Taught tuition fees for 2009 = £6,800 to £9,720 per year

International Postgraduate Scholarship	International Postgraduate Scholarships are available to postgraduate degree applicants and are worth half the tuition fees (e.g. 50% discount on fees). Applications are welcome from students who have achieved first class results in their final degree classification and can demonstrate high academic achievement and social and community involvement.
