Scholarship applicants must hold an offer of admission to a Liverpool Hope University programme. All scholarship applications are reviewed by the Liverpool Hope Student Finance Committee and the decision is final.

Application deadlines apply: September entry, 28th June 1700 GMT; January entry, 28th October 1700 GMT; except Commonwealth Shared Scholarship, 1st May.

Commonwealth Shared Scholarship – MA International Perspectives on Education

Liverpool Hope University is proud to announce it will award one Commonwealth Shared Scholarship to an applicant in MA International Perspectives on Education for September 2010. The Department for International Development and Liverpool Hope University will jointly meet the full costs of an award holder's study in the United Kingdom including tuition fees, return air fares to and from the United Kingdom, and monthly stipend.

Criteria for Commonwealth Shared Scholarship - MA International Perspectives on Education: Eligibility for the award is deemed as in the Commonwealth Shared Scholarship 2010 prospectus available at <http://www.cscuk.org.uk/apply/sharedschol.asp>

How applications for the Commonwealth Shared Scholarship are judged: Applications are judged on the basis of the Commonwealth Shared Scholarship Application Form and the relevant supporting documentation.

The applications are reviewed in the month after the deadline by the Liverpool Hope University Student Finance Committee and a applicant is nominated to the Commonwealth Scholarship Commission.

How to apply for Commonwealth Shared Scholarship: Applicants should be made through the Commonwealth Shared Scholarship Electronic Application System at www.cscuk.org.uk/apply/eas.asp . The deadline is 1st May 2010.

International Postgraduate Scholarship

International Postgraduate Scholarships are available to postgraduate taught (Masters) applicants and are worth half the tuition fees (e.g. 50% discount on fees, between £3,490 and £4,990). International Postgraduate Scholarships are awarded by the decision of the University Committee and are based on academic merit plus demonstrable social and community involvement.

Criteria for International Postgraduate Scholarship: Applications are welcome from international students who have achieved high academic results in their final degree classification and can demonstrate high academic achievement, active university, society and community involvement, and future aspirations to enhance the social and economic development of their home country. This may include academic achievement, involvement in activities in your previous university/community/work place, any charity or volunteer work, plus how you intend to become involved in university life and Liverpool Hope University.

How applications for International Postgraduate Scholarships are judged: International Postgraduate Scholarship applications are awarded on submission of the International Scholarship Application Form and relevant supporting documentation. Particular attention is taken to the applicants social and community involvement. The applications are reviewed in the month after the deadline by the Liverpool Hope University Student Finance Committee.

How to apply for an International Postgraduate Scholarship: Applicants must hold an offer of admission for a Liverpool Hope postgraduate taught degree programme and complete the International Scholarship Application Form with supporting documentation.

Overseas Scholarship – Undergraduate and Postgraduate

Overseas Scholarships are awarded on the basis of academic merit. Overseas Scholarships are available to both undergraduate degree and postgraduate (Masters) degree applicants. For undergraduates, the award is worth up to £3,000 (that is £1,000 award per year subject to satisfactory academic progress); for postgraduates, the award is worth £1,000. The number of Overseas Scholarships available is unlimited.

Criteria for Overseas Scholarship - Undergraduate: Applications are welcome from international students who have achieved, in aggregate, first class marks in their higher secondary education.

Criteria for Overseas Scholarship - Postgraduate: Applications are welcome from international students who have achieved first class results in their final degree classification.

How applications for the Overseas Scholarships are judged: Applications are judged on the basis of the application to your chosen programme of study plus supporting documentation.

How to apply for Overseas Scholarship: Applicants are assessed on the application to the chosen programme of study plus supporting documentation. At the initial stage there is no need to complete a separate application form. However, should further information be required (for example, final certificate), applicants are required to complete the International Scholarship Application Form.

Application deadlines apply: September entry, 28th June 1700 GMT; January entry, 28th October 1700 GMT; except Commonwealth Shared Scholarship, 1st May.
