

Curriculum Structure for Conversion Students

The Conversion Course can take one to two year depending on your accredited learning. If you are taking the course over two years then in the first year you must study a 1 x 60 credit, year long course, *Foundations of Psychology (FOP)*. If you are going into the second year of the course or you are doing the Conversion Course in 1 year then you must take the following courses: the *Dissertation, the Core Course Level I* and in the second semester you will study the second half of *Human Development, Personality and Individual Differences* which is the half that focuses on personality rather than developmental psychology (it will show up as PSYH002X2 on your profile rather than PSYH002) . In addition to this you must take the *Negotiated Learning Contract (PSYHNN1)* for the Conversion Course which involves submitting **ONE** 2,500 word essay from the following topics:

- Cognitive Psychology
- Biological Psychology
- Social Psychology
- Developmental Psychology

NB: The range of courses available in the second year of the conversion course at level H changes from year to year. If you are currently doing the Conversion Course over two years then structure of the second year will change slightly in 2010.
