



Expenditure can be categorised into 4 main areas:


£21m Teaching related

KEY FACTS ABOUT STAFF COSTS

- £29 million was spent on staff costs
- 61% of the staff costs relate to academic staff to support SSR (Student Staff Ratio) of 1:14.3
- Over 75% of academic staff are qualified to doctoral level Liverpool Hope University is in the top 10 of all UK Universities for percentage of academic staff with doctorates.
- The University does not outsource any services (all services are provided in-house)





OTHER OPERATING EXPENDITURE




432 Students have benefitted from Scholarship Funds

Year on year the the University has seen an increase in students' entry points which is averaging 120 new UCAS tarrif points.



INVESTMENT

The University continues to invest in capital developments without borrowing. Over the summer, the University has been busy refurbishing the Cornerstone Building, and creating an Arts Centre in one of the newly purchased buildings at the Creative Campus.
