1 Implementation

This document shall apply initially from 22nd March 2023. Minor revisions were approved at Senate in March 2024.

2 General

These tables list all types of qualification offered by the University, and are consistent with the national *Framework of Higher Education Qualifications*.

Students who become eligible for the award of any of these qualifications will be issued with a formal certificate.

In addition, the University will issue transcripts to students who complete all credit-rated provision, including isolated CPD modules [which do not appear in the Framework and for which no formal Certificate is available].

The tables indicate the level of each qualification in relation to the UK Framework of Higher Education Qualifications [FHEQ]. This may be converted to alternative terminology used at the University as follows:
