






WHERE ARE MY TUITION FEES BEING SPENT?





2. Teaching Related Support £2,805





KEY FACTS ABOUT STAFF COSTS


- £33 million was spent on staff costs
- 65% of the staff costs relate to academic staff – to support SSR (Student Staff Ratio) of 1:17.8
- Over 77% of academic staff are qualified to doctoral level.
- The University does not outsource any services (all services are provided in-house)

STAFF BREAKDOWN


