



£26.9m Teaching related




£9.5m Teaching related support





£6.3m Campus facilities







KEY FACTS ABOUT STAFF COSTS


- £36 million was spent on staff costs
- 67% of the staff costs relate to academic staff to support SSR (Student Staff Ratio) of 1:15.9
- Over 74% of academic staff are qualified to doctoral level.
- The University does not outsource any services (all services are provided in-house)


37 Students have benefitted from Scholarship Funds

EXPENDITURE SUPPORTS 5,452 STUDENTS

Year on year the the University has seen an increase in students' entry points which is averaging 116 UCAS tarrif points.

The University continues to invest in capital developments without borrowing. During the year 2021/22, the University invested in its buildings, equipment and infastructure with spend of £6.918million.
