- 5. To consider recommendations from the Research Ethics Sub-committee on the implementation of the University's Research Ethics policy*
- 6. To consider key updates of the School/Department Research Committees*
- 7. To take overall responsibility for the University's planning for the next REF* and to receive minutes from the REF Steering Group (REFSG)
- 8. To recommend to Senate the formal recognition of University Research Centres
- 9. To review annual reports of Research Centres and recommend to Senate either continuation of Centre status or, if appropriate, other courses of action
- 10. To act as the University's principal forum for consideration of external information relating to research within a Higher Education (e.g. UKRI and ResearchEngland) context.
