Rules and Regulations for 6th Formers

Protecting and updating your data

- Your information will not be used or disclosed to other readers, including family members.
- Notify the library immediately if you lose your card. A £5.00 charge is made for a replacement, unless the card was stolen, in which case a police crime number is required to enable the charge to be waived.

Security

- You will be required to show your ID card to gain admittance to The Sheppard-Worlock Library. You cannot access the building if you do not have your Library card.
- You must present your ID card and sign in at the Security Desk each time you enter the Library.
- You must sign out at the Security Desk when leaving the Library.
- You must not use anybody else's ID card to gain entry to the Library.
- Please take care of your bags, coats and belongings. Do not leave them unattended at any time.
- All users must be registered with the Library. Please note that members of Library staff or Liverpool Hope security personnel may ask you for proof of membership i.e. your ID card.
- Membership of the library can be withdrawn or suspended in relation to theft, misbehaviour, debt, damage, etc. If this should happen we will notify your school.
- Sixth formers must vacate the building during IT access only periods.

• All photocopying undertaken must abide by the advertised current copyright legislation and licence.

Respect your learning environment

- Mobile phones must be switched to silent on entering the building. Calls should only be received or made in the designated Phone Zones.
