
Postgraduate Certificate in Education, Leadership & Management

Duration: 12 months | Delivery: Online | Start date: February 2024

Course Aims

- Develop a critical understanding of theoretical approaches to leadership, relevant to educational practice.
- Enhance knowledge and critical understanding of applied leadership and management in an education context.
- Provide knowledge and critical understanding of key theories and concepts within the field of change management, and of the role of leadership in providing strategic direction and in leading change.
- Develop a critical understanding of those factors which influence individual and collective behaviour/s within organisations.
- Enable students to make informed decisions by creatively and systematically applying the knowledge and understanding of key concepts and best practice.
- Support students' continuing personal and professional development so as to enable them to work as
 reflective practitioners with self-direction and originality, willing to take on a leadership role and contributing to
 the success of their own teams, organisations and their students.

Module Overview

This Postgraduate Certificate (60 Level 7 Credits) comprises two x 30 credit modules:

- Education Leadership & Management I: Perspectives on Leadership (30 Credits).
 Recognising the challenges faced by those in leadership roles and the need to support the development of leadership competencies at all levels, this module explores leadership, with a specific focus on leadership within different education organisations. In particular, the module explores the nature of leadership and management through a number of different thematic 'lenses' and considers the role leaders play within improvement and change programmes.
- Education Leadership & Management II: Working Effectively with Others (30 Credits). This module takes as its focus the need for all those working within schools and other education institutions to develop positive and productive relationships with others. Leadership and management do not occur in a vacuum, and this module has been designed to develop both functional knowledge and critical understanding of a number of key perspectives on human behaviour within organisations and on the nature and processes of organising human activity. As such it is designed not only to encourage the development of solutions to specific leadership and management problems but also to provide participants with insights into the complex nature of organisations and of organisational life.

Delivery

Both modules will be delivered on a part-time basis through fully online learning including:

- Access to Liverpool Hopes Virtual Learning Environment
- Online seminars via Zoom
- Online discussion forums
- Access to Liverpool Hope University's Electronic Library
- Guided Reading
- Assessment support via email and zoom

Assessment

Assessment comprises a mix of formative tasks, critical reflection and case studies. Equivalent 6000 words per 30 credit module.

Entry requirements

First Class or Upper Second Class Honours
Degree in a relevant discipline (applications
from participants who do not hold a 1st or
2:1 Honours Degree (or equivalent), but have
appropriate professional experience will be
considered).

Due to the leadership specialism the expectation of the applicant will be that they have gained some leadership experience within an education or care setting. Normally they will be engaged in a leadership role at the time of starting on the programme but aspirational leaders will also be considered if they have the support to engage with leadership practice within their setting.

International Entry Requirements

For students whose first language is not English there is a language requirement of IELTS 6.5 overall with 6.0 minimum of all components.
