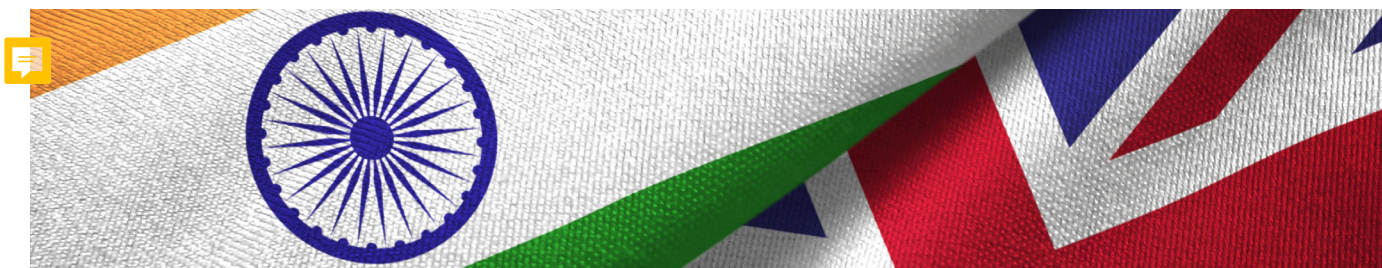

Food and shopping

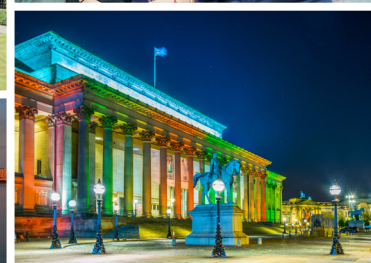
There are many Indian restaurants, grocery stores, and spice shops, particularly around areas like Bold Street and Smithdown Road.
