International students must apply through the <u>UCAS</u> system.

Postgraduate Taught Degrees (Master's)

Applications for postgraduate taught degrees are made directly to Liverpool Hope University via the online Postgraduate Application Form. Before applying, ensure you have the following documents:

- A scanned copy of your passport
- Academic qualifications
- English language proficiency certificate
- Any previous UK visas (if applicable)

After submitting the online application form, you'll need to email these documents to postgraduate@hope.ac.uk

Postgraduate Research Degrees

- We currently have over 150 postgraduate research students conducting specialist research and collaborating with academic staff who are working at the frontiers of their subjects.
- We offer both PhD (Doctor of Philosophy) and Professional Doctorate degrees.
- Professional Doctorate degrees are available in Education (EdD), Social Work (DSW), and Health & Social Care (DHSC)

Visa Requirements

If you require a UK Student Route visa:

Apply up to 6 months before your course start date.

The university recommends applying at least 3 months in advance.

CAS

To obtain a Confirmation of Acceptance for Studies (CAS), you must:

- Accept your offer.
- Meet all academic and English language conditions.
- Complete the CAS Shield process
- Pass a Pre-CAS credibility interview if required* (See list of countries)

- Pay a 50% tuition fee deposit.
