

Indian Partners Postgraduate Program Fee Package Details 2022-23 for Non-IMBA

Criteria for application:

- Student must be nominated by their home institution
- Students must have completed a year of postgraduate study at their home institution
- Students are normally required to have an IELTS score of 6.5 or more, with a minimum of 6 in reading and writing, and 5.5 in speaking and listening, this is in keeping with the University's international admissions policy. This is also the criteria for a Student Route Visa application

At Liverpool Hope University

Students will complete a full Ma or MSc degree at Liverpool Hope with 52 weeks of teaching and a full credit load of 180 UK credits (120 credits taught and 60 credits dissertation)

Following nomination and application, the student will receive a course offer relating to the chosen study option and should accept within the deadline given.

Fees

All students who accept a course offer for the Indian Partners PG Program at Liverpool Hope University must pay the inclusive Fee Package as set out below. This document explains what is included.

Fee Package Details

The Fee Package is the combined range of benefits you will receive for the discounted fee attached to this Programme. It may show as 'Tuition Fee' on your Offer, but actually includes a lot more, such as airport collection on Arrival Day, accommodation, orientation and a catering card.

The Fee Package in a room with shared bathrooms is £7,050

The Fee Package in a room with a private bathroom is £7,626 (subject to availability – not guaranteed)

Please note that the above fees will increase for students arriving in 2023/4.

How to pay the Fee Package

You will be required to pay the Fee Package as directed in the Course Offer. Payments can be made through the Liverpool Hope Payment Portal

Airport Collection

If you arrive on one of the Arrival Days (24 September or 3 October 2022), you will be collected from Manchester International Airport and taken by taxi to your accommodation on campus. A member of staff will normally be at the campus to meet you. Please try to travel in a group and arrive together.

Students arriving on other dates should make their own arrangements to travel from the airport to their accommodation. We can try to book an airport pick-up for you, subject to a supplement of £50 payable in advance. Availability is low at this time of year and a booking may not be possible at short notice.

Orientation

The University's Global Centre offers an orientation programme immediately after the first Arrival Day (Saturday 24 September 2022). Students arriving after this date may miss useful sessions. All students will be given a campus tour, plus help and advice about how to use public transport, opening a bank account and registering with a doctor

Tuition

Your Tutors will provide details of your degree via Moodle (the online learning environment). You will study a full degree programme of 180 UK credits including the Dissertation or Project. You will be in class with full-degree seeking postgraduate students at Hope Park.

Accommodation

You will be offered a private room on campus with shared bathrooms. Applications to upgrade to an en-suite room are subject to availability and a fee supplement.

The room includes heating, lighting, unlimited WiFi, access to a launderette, computer lab and common room, plus the support of 24-hour Security and the Residential Life Team.

It is likely that you will live at the Aigburth Park campus, which is about three miles from the main teaching campus (Hope Park). Aigburth Park is near to many local facilities, plus easy public transport to the centre of Liverpool.

A free shuttle bus is available Monday to Friday during the day in term time, to get you back and forth to classes.

You will be expected to actively join the student community in the Halls of Residence and to enter into any social events and support the Senior Resident Tutors who live on the campus.

To register for a room on Campus you must complete the on-line accommodation application at https://accommodation.hope.ac.uk/Acc_auth/

Room offers will be made by email and include the accommodation contract, which sets out the terms and conditions for living on campus. You must accept the contract online and pay a deposit of £200 to secure your room - this is refundable after departure (conditions apply) and is not part of the Fee Package.

Catering

The Fee Package includes a catering card with credit of £450, to be used in the restaurants and

coffee shops, the bar area and the convenience store on campus. The card can also be used to purchase stationary items, gifts, or University branded clothing in the Varsity Store at Hope Park. Take-away food can be purchased from Our Place to take home.

The catering card is to be used at the Hope Park campus during the teaching weeks of the programme - it is not operational anywhere off-campus or at Aigburth Park, where there is no café, shop or bar. Therefore, catering in the evenings, weekends and the holiday periods is the responsibility of the student. All study rooms have access to a self-catering kitchen for making meals.

Any credit left on the card at the end of the programme will NOT be refunded, so students are advised to use all the credit on the card, but if any credit remains when you leave, it can be donated to charity via the Global Centre.

Lost cards should be reported to the University who will issue a new card with the same balance as the lost card (a £5 administration fee will be made for supplying a replacement card).

Other benefits of the Package

- the services of the Residential Life Team and 24-hour security staff
- free shuttle buses to and from the teaching campuses (Hope Park or Creative Campus)
- the services of the support team in the International Hub
- unrestricted use of the Library and IT facilities at all locations
- free, unlimited WiFi in your study room and all communal areas
- the services of our counselling and academic support teams
- free membership of the gym and sports facilities at Hope Park (subject to an induction fee)
- free membership of the Liverpool Hope Students' Union

Not included in the Package

- flights and any incoming transport other than the Manchester airport pick-up on Arrivals Day
- travel/medical insurance, or insurance for personal belongings
- cooking equipment for communal kitchens
- cutlery and crockery
- any costs connected to social activity off campus, optional cultural trips or travel
- food costs other than the Catering Card (see 'Catering' above)
- cleaning of study bedrooms and kitchens; this is the students' responsibility
- transport back to the airport at the end of the program

Cancelling a place on the Programme

- if you cancel after you have been nominated but before receiving the Course Offer, you can cancel without paying any fees
- if you cancel after receiving the Course Offer, tuition fees may apply, depending on the reason
- if you cancel after accepting the accommodation contract, the £200 room deposit is not refundable

Award

On successful completion of the course at Liverpool Hope University, students will receive a postgraduate Masters degree awarded by Liverpool Hope University.

Graduation

The student, subject to meeting the criteria for graduation, will be invited to attend the next Graduation Ceremony (usually held in July and January each year). Students are entitled to two tickets for guests.
